



# Come Teach at the Calgary Waldorf School

## Who are we?

Founded in 1985, the Calgary Waldorf School offers a full and well-rounded program to over 300 students from preschool to grade nine. We are very fortunate to have mainly full classes and a spacious, beautiful facility in which to work. Our faculty is made up of 45 full and part time teachers, administrators and support staff. The school is managed by an Executive Council and a Faculty Council in partnership with a Board of Directors made up of faculty and parents. CWS is a developing member of AWSNA, currently working towards full membership. We maintain a supportive relationship with the Alberta government, receiving 35% of our revenue from private education grants. Consequently, we can offer reasonable tuition rates lower than many private schools. We also have a tuition assistance fund, allowing diversity in our community and strengthening the social fabric of our school.

## Where are we?

Our beautifully designed school, built in 2002, sits on the outer western edge of the thriving city of Calgary, located in the province of Alberta. Calgary offers all of the cultural and artistic events of a major city, but the real jewel of the city is its proximity to the stunning Rocky Mountains, which are one hour away and draw many outdoor enthusiasts. Here, our classes often enjoy outdoor field trips together to hike, ski, camp, cycle, or canoe.

## Who are we searching for?

Early each spring, we begin our search for experienced class and subject teachers for the upcoming school year, who are eligible for an Alberta Teaching Certificate (i.e. hold a Bachelor of Education degree). We will favour applicants with Waldorf certification or training and proven teaching experience. We offer significant financial and practical support for ongoing Waldorf training and we have a successful mentoring program, which includes input from our on-site mentor and experienced faculty members and visiting master teachers. We are looking for warm, imaginative, committed and dynamic individuals to join our faculty and community.

## What do we offer?

Our salaries range from \$48,000 - \$85,000 Canadian, depending on training and experience. We also offer a full benefits package, a teacher retirement fund, and a 50% reduction of tuition for children of faculty and staff.
